1. Handicap will be figured on the following in the listed order:
 - a. Highest 2023/2024 season USBC sanctioned average (21 games or more).
 - b. Highest 2024/2025 average as of March 1, 2026 (21 games or more).
 - c. Highest most current USBC average of 21 games or more on BOWL.COM
 - d. If no sanctioned average, the bowler will use JDIPBT average.
 - e. If you do not have a sanctioned or JDIPBT average, men will use 170 and women will use 150.
2. The handicap is 90% of 230.
3. All entrants must be a JD employee, a retiree or JD employee on layoff with recall rights and as per UAW & JD bereavement agreement which covers: grandmother, grandfather, granddaughter, grandson, father, mother, mother-in-law, father-in-law, brother, sister, spouse, son, daughter, son-in-law, daughter-in-law, stepchild, stepfather, stepmother, stepbrother, stepsister, and the employee's spouses, brother, sister & grandparents can also bowl. Children must be over 18 by March 1, 2025 to bowl in the Tournament.
4. USBC rules govern this tournament. Tournament Director has final say on all disputes.
5. USBC rule 319 will be in effect with the following exceptions: 319a-2 (10-pin rule) and 319c (rerating) applies to USBC members only. Please be aware of rule 319c and 319a-3 (bowler's responsible for verifying their own average) and 319a-4 (time limits for making corrections). Tournament Director has final say in any dispute.
6. A person may bowl only once in an event. All teams and doubles will bowl in the order submitted.
7. All persons bowling doubles must bowl singles and vice-versa. Doubles will be bowled before singles. Double and singles will be bowled on the same pair of lanes.
8. A limit of one PBA or LPBT member is allowed on each 4-person team or each 2 person doubles team.
9. All prize money is returned 100%. Prize ratio will be at least 1 out of 6.
10. Closing date for entries will be March 1, 2026. Fees must accompany entry form and there will be no refund after closing date.
11. Out of town entries will have scheduling preference over local entries.
12. No open bowling before shifts. Bowlers will be allowed approximately 10 minutes practice before shift starts.
13. The Tournament Director reserves the right to add additional dates/squads as needed. *Additional shifts may need to be added for doubles and singles depending on participation numbers.*
14. The Tournament Director has final say in all matters.
